PRESS NOTE

Subject: Schedule for General Election to the Legislative Assemblies of BIHAR, JHARKHAND AND HARYANA.

The terms of the Legislative Assemblies of Bihar and Jharkhand are due to expire on the 6th March, 2005 and that of Haryana on the 8th March 2005 in terms of Article 172 (1) of the Constitution.

2. By virtue of its powers, duties and functions under Article 324 read with Articles 172 (1) and 174(1) of the Constitution of India and Section 15 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951, the Commission is under a constitutional mandate to hold elections to constitute new Legislative Assemblies in the States of Bihar, Jharkhand and Haryana. There are 243 Assembly Constituencies in Bihar, 81 Assembly Constituencies in Jharkhand and 90 Assembly Constituencies in Haryana.

ELECTORAL ROLLS

3. The electoral rolls in the States of Bihar, Jharkhand and Haryana are being summarily revised with reference to 1.1.2005 as the qualifying date and as per the present programme already announced, the electoral rolls for these States will be finally published on 3.1.2005.

4. The final electoral rolls shall be published and displayed on 3.1.2005 at all designated locations, i.e., all polling stations and delivery post offices for the benefit of electors. The copies of finally published electoral rolls shall also be made available to all recognized National and State political parties. In terms of the law regarding registration of electors, further changes by way of additions, deletions, corrections or transposition can only be carried out till the last date for nominations. The Commission, therefore, appeals to all eligible electors to check their names and entries in the electoral rolls and in case of any omission or commission in respect of their

entries, approach the Assistant Electoral Registration Officer or Electoral Registration Officer of their constituency well in time for corrective action.

IDENTIFICATION OF VOTERS

5. In consonance with the past practice, the Commission has decided that compulsory identification of voters with the means of Electors' Photo Identity Card (EPIC) will be made in the General Election to the State Legislative Assemblies of the three States. In order to ensure that no voter is deprived of his/her franchise, if his/her name figures in the Electoral Rolls, separate instructions will be issued prescribing alternative documents for the identification of electors at the time of poll.

ELECTRONIC VOTING MACHINES

6. The Commission has steadily expanded the use of Electronic Voting Machines (EVMs) in elections since November 1998. During general elections to Lok Sabha and four Legislative Assemblies held in April-May, 2004, EVMs were used through out the country for the first time. In keeping with the existing practice, the Commission has decided to use these machines in all Assembly Constituencies in the State of Bihar, Jharkhand and Haryana. Adequate numbers of EVMs are already available in each state and training and awareness building programmes for the election staff, political parties and general public have been started afresh for this round of elections. Instructions have been issued to all Returning Officers to give special attention to the preparation of machines and training of Presiding Officers and Sector Magistrates in the use of machines.

DEPLOYMENT OF FORCES AND LAW & ORDER

7. Sufficient Central Para-Military Forces (CPMFs) will be provided to these States for maintaining law and order, and the security of polling personnel, candidates, electors and the EVMs. The forces will be deployed in various constituencies in consultation with the Observers. In its endeavour to maintain law & order during election period, these States have been asked to execute all non-bailable warrants, launch special drives to unearth illegal arms and make preventive arrests. The District Magistrates will make a detailed individual review for

assessment of all licensed arm holders, and if considered necessary shall get their arms deposited in the District Armoury for the period of elections.

OBSERVERS

8. The Commission in the past was deploying two General Observers and one Expenditure Observer in each district for monitoring elections. This time, Commission has decided to deploy one General Observer in each assembly constituency and at least one Expenditure Observer in each district to supervise the conduct of elections.

CONDUCT OF OFFICIALS

9. The Commission has issued several instructions to ensure impartiality of government officials and their non-involvement in the electoral politics. In spite of these instructions, Commission had received several complaints during the previous elections regarding biased and partial behaviour of certain government servants who were engaged in connection with elections. Commission desires to make it clear, in unambiguous terms that the conduct of all government officials who have been entrusted with election related responsibilities and duties would remain under constant scrutiny. The Commission will take a very serious note of any lapses in this regard.

10. The Commission in order to ensure free and fair polls has already given instructions to the three State Governments to transfer all election related officials, Police Officers of the rank of Sub Inspector and above engaged in maintenance of law and order and Sergeant Majors from their home districts. Instructions have also been issued that these officers shall not be allowed to continue in the same district if they have completed a period of three years in that district during last four years. The State Governments have also been instructed to transfer all those officers who were charged / transferred for any misconduct or lapse while performing election related duties in the past by the Election Commission, from the posts entailing election work.

SECRECY OF VOTE

11. The Commission has decided that it will be the personal responsibility of every Presiding Officer to ensure that secrecy of vote is maintained in all respect at the time of poll in the polling station. No individual shall be allowed to accompany any elector to the voting compartment except in case of blind and infirm voter who are entitled to be accompanied under the law. No photography, video or still, shall also be allowed inside the polling stations.

COMMUNICATION SYSTEM

12. The District Election Officers in these States have been asked to set up a comprehensive communication system to facilitate quick complaint redressal during the election period. They have also been asked to open Helplines / Control Rooms in each constituency for the convenience of electors.

VIDEOGRAPHY

13. The Commission has already issued detailed guidelines for Videography of critical events during the election process and polling at sensitive / hypersensitive polling booths on the poll day. The District Election Officers shall follow these instructions scrupulously.

CITIZENS, MEDIA AND NON-GOVERNMENTAL ORGANISATIONS

14. The Commission urges to all electors, media and all non-governmental organisations to perform an active and responsible role in the forthcoming elections.

MODEL CODE OF CONDUCT

15. The Model Code of Conduct comes into effect immediately from now onwards. The Code will apply to the whole of the States of Bihar, Jharkhand and Haryana and will be applicable to all Political Parties and to the State Governments of Bihar, Jharkhand and Haryana and the Union Government, in so far as these three States are concerned.

SCHEDULE

16. The Commission, after taking into consideration all relevant factors, has decided to recommend to the Governors of these three States to issue notification for the said general elections under the relevant provisions of the Representation of the People Act, 1951 as per the following schedule:

SCHEDULE FOR ELECTIONS

The Commission has decided to hold General Elections to Legislative Assembly of Haryana in one phase and General Elections to the Legislative Assemblies of Bihar and Jharkhand in three phases each.

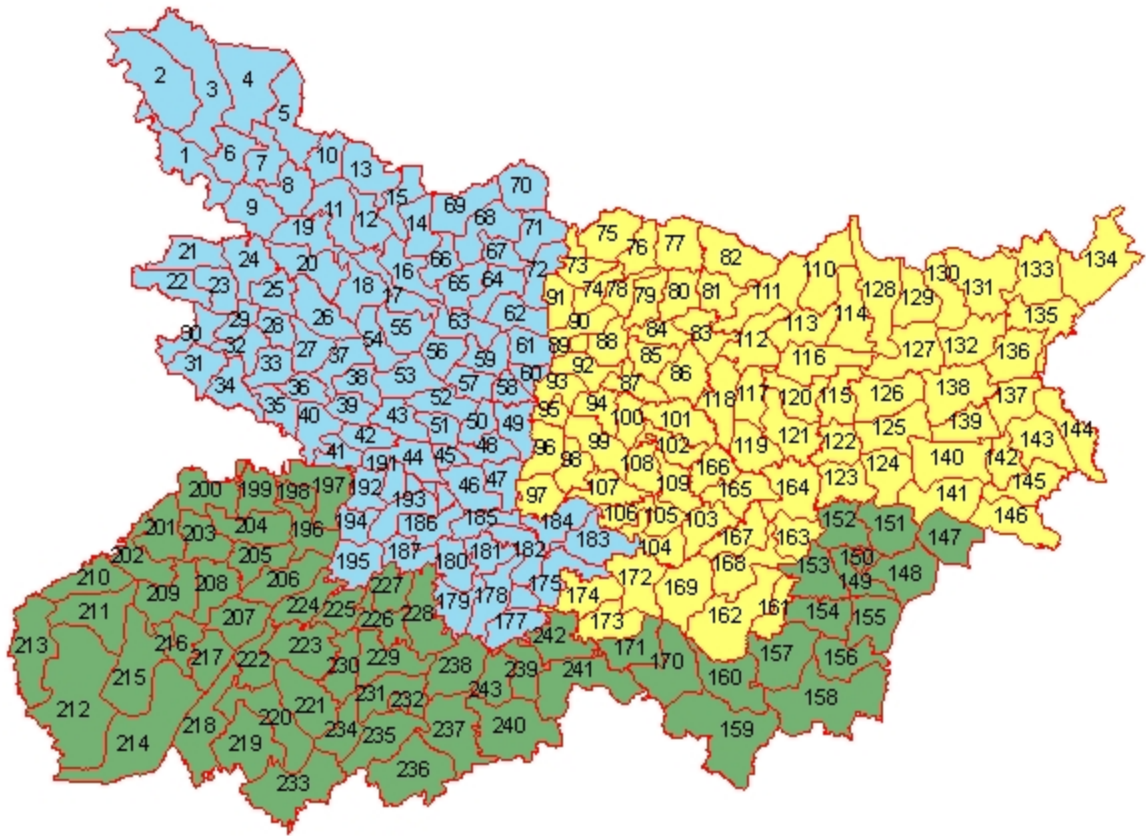
